This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Triyani P.S. Case No. 99 of 2014 (G.R.No. 336), disclosing the offence under Section 366/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering the statement of the victim lady, recorded under Section 164 of the Cr. P.C., which has been brought on record by way of Annexure-3 to the application, the same is allowed. Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest/surrender within six weeks from today in the court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each, with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief



Judicial Magistrate, Sheohar in connection with Triyani P.S.
Case No. 99 of 2014, subject to the condition as laid down
under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

This is subject to the condition that the petitioners
shall present themselves before the Police/Court, as the case
may be, as and when required and in the event of failure on their
part to appear before the court on two consecutive occasions,
their bail bonds shall be liable to be cancelled.
