3 13-09-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner who is in custody since 16.03.2019
has filed the instant application for grant of bail in connection
with Bodh Gaya P.S. Case No. 68 of 2013 registered for the
offence punishable under sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 324, 341,
342, 307, 302, 333, 337, 338, 322, 224, 225, 353, 120B and 379
of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the allegation in the FIR, while some accused
persons were being taken away by the police, the police party
was attacked by a large mob.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and his name
transpired on the basis of suspicion in course of investigation.
He further submits that his case stands on a similar footing to



that of five other co-accused who have been enlarged on bail by order dated 14.07.2014 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 16542 of 2014 and that he is in custody since 16.03.2019 i.e. nearly six months.

The application for bail has been opposed by learned APP for the State.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case including the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 16.03.2019, the Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gaya in connection with Bodh-Gaya P.S. Case No. 68 of 2013.
