ORAL ORDER

2 27-06-2019 Heard both sides.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Balrampur P.S. case No. 12 of 2019 registered under Section 498A of the IPC and u/s 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is ready to keep his wife with all honour and dignity.

Taking into consideration the facts aforesaid and the undertaking given by the petitioner that he is ready to keep his wife with all proper care, the petitioner, above named, is directed to surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/ production of a copy of this order and on such the learned court below shall enlarge the



petitioner on provisional anticipatory bail for four months on his furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Katihar in connection with Balrampur P.S. case No. 12 of 2019, subject to conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure. Thereafter, the learned court below shall make all efforts for resolving the dispute between the husband and wife and if the petitioner is ready to keep his wife properly the provisional bail granted to the petitioner shall be confirmed. If the petitioner fails to keep his wife properly, the learned court below shall dispose of the provisional bail of the petitioner, in accordance with law, immediately after four months.
