Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned

APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in **Bhargama P.S. Case No.92 of 2019** instituted for the offence under Section(s) 379, 411 Indian Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no description of the mobile phone, which has allegedly been stolen from the informant.

It is alleged in the written report that on the date of occurrence mobile of the informant was snatched by some unknown persons while he was going on motorcycle. It is further alleged that the informant learnt that this petitioner had snatched his mobile phone. The informant went to the house of this petitioner with other villagers on 01.05.2019 and caught



hold him with snatched mobile.

In the written report, there is no description given by the informant of the mobile phone allegedly stolen from his possession. The mobile phone, which has been recovered from possession of the petitioner, has no any identifying marks to show that it belongs to informant.

Petitioner has enclosed production cum seizure list, wherein, it is mentioned that one mobile phone has been produced by the informant.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Judicial Magistrate, 1st class, Araria**, in connection with **Bhargama P.S. Case No.92 of 2019**, subject to the condition that both the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.
