Petitioner seeks bail in **Parsa P.S. Case No.124 of 2019** instituted for the offence under Section 414/34 Indian Penal Code and Section(s) 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is alleged that 350 Kg. jaggery and 25 Kg. *Naushadar* was recovered from tempo of the petitioner in which two persons were found sitting.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that Petitioner is in custody since 21.04.2019 having clean antecedents.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of



Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **ADJ-11th cum Special Judge, Excise Act, Saran at Chapra**, in connection with **Parsa P.S. Case No.124 of 2019**, subject to the condition that both the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.
