learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Rohtas
P.S. Case No. 262 of 2018 for the offenses under Sections
386/395 of I.P.C. and 17/18 U.A.P. Act and 17 C.L.A. Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has no criminal antecedent. The petitioner is not
associated with the people alleged by the informant. Learned
counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is
known to the informant. The date of occurrence is 19.09.2018
and the date of F.I.R. is 22.09.2018. The delay is not explained.
Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the other
co-accused had been granted bail. The petitioner is in custody
since 24.09.2018.



Considering the fact that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he has remained in the custody since 24.09.2018 and there is a delay in lodging F.I.R., the Court is inclined to grant him bail. Let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Dehri, Rohtas District in connection with Rohtas P.S. Case No. 262 of 2018.
