The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under  
Section 414 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation is that the informant along with other  
police party was on patrolling duty and he saw that one  
suspicious truck was coming from Patna and with the help of  
police party stopped the truck and demanded paper from the  
driver, but he did not produce the paper.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that  
the petitioner is in custody since 22.02.2019 and has got no  
criminal antecedent. Charge sheet has been submitted in this  
case. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged  
against the petitioner. The petitioner is alleged to be the driver



of the truck in question. The petitioner had no knowledge that the truck in question is stolen property. The petitioner is not the owner of the said stolen truck.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Hajipur Sadar P.S. case No.87 of 2019.
