2 16-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody for the offence
under Sections 363,365,366A of the Indian Penal Code.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is
that though in the FIR allegation is of kidnapping of the
daughter of the informant. However, the victim in her statement
recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. has not alleged that
petitioner had kidnapped her rather she has specifically stated
that she had voluntarily gone to the house of her relative.

Considering the statement of the victim under Section
164 Cr.P.C., let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail,
on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with
two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the
learned Court below where the case is pending in connection
with Meenapur P.S. Case No.140 of 2019, with following
conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial



jurisdiction of the learned Court below having immovable property in his name.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
