7 13-03-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 304(B)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is husband of the victim of dowry death. The petitioner is in custody since 25.06.2016. The report of the learned trial judge reveals that out of nine only two prosecution witnesses have been examined up-till now.

Considering the period already undergone by the petitioner and undertaking of the petitioner that he shall fully co-operate with the trial and shall not indulge in tampering of the evidence etc., let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty



Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Mahila Police Station Case No.19 of 2016, subject to condition that both the bailors shall be resident of within the territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below and the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
