ORAL ORDER

2 15-07-2019 The petitioner claims to be an ex-Army personnel.

Under the scheme of Government of India/State Government, in appropriate cases, land can be settled with them for agricultural purpose. The petitioner is said to have filed an application before the Circle Officer, Mohiuddin Nagar, Samastipur, a copy of which has been brought on record by way of Annexure-2. Annexure-2 does not at all disclose as to when the representation was received by the office of the Circle Officer. However, considering the facts and circumstances, this writ application is disposed of with an observation that if petitioner



approaches the appropriate authority seeking any relief for settlement of land, the same shall be considered in accordance with law and disposed of preferably within three months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.

This writ application is disposed of with aforesaid observation.
