2 26-06-2019 The learned counsel for the parties are in agreement that the order dated 27.03.2019 passed by the Commissioner, Bhagalpur Division, Bhagalpur is absolutely an unspeaking and one line unjust order and does not depict the reason or the grounds on which the appeal has been dismissed, hence is required to be quashed and the matter deserves to be remitted back to the Commissioner, Bhagalpur Division, Bhagalpur for consideration and fresh adjudication.

Having regard to the submissions, made jointly by the learned counsel for the parties, the order dated 27.03.2019



passed by the Commissioner, Bhagalpur Division, Bhagalpur in Stamp Appeal No. 3 of 2018-19 is quashed and the matter is remitted back to the Commissioner for fresh adjudication on merits and it is expected of him to pass a detailed, well considered, just and legal order, in accordance with law.
