ORAL ORDER

2 28-06-2019 This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail in connection with Excise Case No.182 of 2019, disclosing offence under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Prosecution story is of recovery of huge quantity of liquor from the road side near the house of one Dhoily Das.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner nor from his house and he was made accused on the basis of suspicion. He has no criminal antecedent.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, considering the fact that as there is no specific allegation of recovery either from his house or from his conscious possession, this application is allowed.



Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of learned 2nd Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge Excise Act, Samastipur, in connection with Excise Case No.182 of 2019, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
