2 16-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for
the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under Sections
302, 201, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and 27 of the Arms Act.

The prosecution case in brief is that son of the informant had
gone to watch dance at village-Basti Bigha and in course of dance
programme, he was shot dead by the accused persons.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that there is no
allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner.
The petitioner is in custody since 01-04-2019. Charge sheet has
already been submitted. The petitioner has been falsely implicated in
the present case. The informant is not an eye witness to the alleged
occurrence. The informant in his restatement, recorded at paragraph-
80 of the case diary, has stated that the deceased had sustained fire-
arms injury by one Sunil Kumar, son of Dudheshwar Yadav. Further



in paragraph-89 of the case diary, one Manish Kumar is said to have been examined who has claimed himself to be an eye witness to the alleged occurrence. The said witness in his statement has stated that it was Sunil Yadav, who fired in drunken state which hit the deceased. There is no allegation of assault alleged against the petitioner as per statement of the eye witnesses. The postmortem report also corroborates the statement, made by said witness, Manish Kumar.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R. He has got criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the petitioner named above is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Arwal, Jehanabad in connection with Rampur Chauram P.S. Case No. 07 of 2019.
