ORAL ORDER

2 27-06-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Mansi P.S. Case No. 51 of 2019, registered under Section
30(b)(c) of the Bihar Excise Act.

The accusation is of recovery of 175 kg sugar,
contained in seven containers, from the Bathan of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is doing the business of sugar and grocery in the name
of M/S Sonal Traders, regarding which, he has obtained
registration certificate and he is paying the GST and Income Tax
but with ulterior motive the present case has been lodged with
false allegation.



Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge (Excise), Khagaria, in connection with Mansi P.S. Case No. 51 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
