APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the
offences under Sections 341, 354-B and 34 of the Indian Penal
Code and 8 of POCSO Act.

Prosecution allegation, in short, is that the accused
persons teased the daughter of the informant and misbehaved
with her.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 12.5.2019 and has got no
criminal antecedent. Charge-sheet/prosecution report has been
submitted in this case. There is no allegation of tampering of
witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner has
falsely been implicated in the present case due to village



politics. The allegations made in the F.I.R. is denied by the petitioner. No offence under Section 354B has been committed by the petitioner.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is directed that the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 1st Additional Sessions Judge -cum- Special Judge, POCSO Act, Araria in connection with Special (POCSO) Case No. 27 of 2018 arising out of Tarabari P.S. Case No. 66 of 2018.
