2 10-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in connection with Fatehpur P.S. Case No.300 of 2016, registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 504, 498A/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of D.P. Act.

Allegation against the co-accused including the petitioners is to have tortured the informant due to non-fulfillment of demanded dowry, however, counsel for the



petitioners submits that the petitioners are father-in-law, mother-in-law, Bhaisur and married Nanad of the informant and there is general and omnibus allegation against them.

Looking to the entire facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioners, above-named, be released on anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-X, Gaya in connection with Fatehpur P.S. Case No.300 of 2016 subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
