ORAL ORDER

6 21-01-2019 Heard learned counsel for petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner, who is in custody, seeks bail in connection with Uphara P.S. Case No. 41 of 2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 302, 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Informant who is Chaukidar of Uphara Police Station has alleged in his fardbeyan that on 22.11.2017 about 19:00 P.M. he received an information and thereafter reached the place of occurrence and saw that a dead body lying in a paddy field of Kapil Saw.

Considering the facts and circumstances and also considering the para nos. 27, 28, 31 and 32 of the case diary, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Hence, the



prayer for bail of the petitioner is hereby rejected.

However, after framing of charge the petitioner
would be at liberty to renew his prayer for bail.
