2 10-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory
bail in connection with Case No. C-III-62/19 registered for the
offence punishable under Section 30 (a) of the Bihar Prohibition
& Excise Act, 2016.

The police has recovered 6.660 litres of foreign
liquor outside the cattle shed of the petitioner. The petitioner,
who is lady, has got no criminal antecedent.

Looking to the quantity of liquor recovered, let the
petitioner, above-named, be released on anticipatory bail in the
event of her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below
within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail



bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge, Excise, Siwan in connection with Case No.C-III-62/19 subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure with a further condition that if the petitioner, after her release in this case, is again found involved in similar nature of cases then the concerned court would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of her bail bonds.
