counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

Petitioner is in custody in connection with Tistauta
P.S. Case No. 37 of 2018 for the offence under sections 414 of
the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a), 32(ii), 38(ii), 41(i) of
Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that
petitioner has no criminal antecedent. He submits that nothing
was recovered from the possession of the petitioner.

He further submits that the persons from whose
possession arms was seized was released taking advantage of
benefit under section 167 of the Cr.P.C.

Considering the fact that petitioner has no criminal



antecedent and he is in custody since 10.7.2018, let the petitioner, named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-2nd cum Special Judge-Excise Act, Vaishali at Hajipur, in connection with Tistauta P.S. Case No. 37 of 2018.
