APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Sections 341, 323, 307, 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case in short is that in the backdrop of
meagre issue, the petitioner abused the informant and tried to
pressed his neck.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation
of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The
petitioner is in custody since 24-09-2018. Charge sheet has
already been submitted. The nature of injury is said to be
simple. No offence u/S 307 of the Indian Penal Code is made
out. Single Lathi blow is alleged to have been made by the



petitioner. There is no repetition of blow by the petitioner.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional District & Sessions Judge-III, Banka in connection with Sessions Trial No. 63 of 2019 arising out of Amarpur (Fullidumar) P.S. Case No. 507 of 2018.
