The petitioner seeks bail in anticipation of his
arrest in connection with Narpatganj P. S. Case No. 330 of
2018 (G.R. No. 1670 of 2018) dated 03.06.2018 instituted
for the offences under Sections 323, 341, 325, 307, 379,
504 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

After some arguments, Mr. Mukesh Kumar Rana,
learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to
