2 12-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Tarapur P.S. Case No. 164 of 2018 for the offences under Sections 366(A)/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 8 of POCSO Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 20.04.2019.

Referring to the statement of the victim under section 164 Cr.P.C. learned counsel for the petitioner submits that allegation against this petitioner is that he was standing at the time when Sumit Kumar took away the victim from the market when she was taking breakfast.



Considering the fact that petitioner has no criminal antecedent, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, let the petitioner, named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court of learned Special Judge (POCSO)-cum-A.D.J. 1st, Munger in connection with Tarapur P.S. Case No. 164 of 2018.
