2 04-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323,
307, 325, 379, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner allegedly caused injury to
Oumul Nesha, the Bhabhi of the informant, with bricks at her
head. The impugned order reveals that Doctor has found cut
injury of 1”x 0.5” on the frontal region caused by blunt object.

Learned counsel for the informant opposed the
prayer for bail.

Let the petitioner, above named, be released
on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty
Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the



satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Manjhagarh Police Station Case No.113 of 2019, subject to the condition that both bailors shall be resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below and further the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
