State.

The petitioner seeks bail in **Barauli P.S. Case No. 211 of 2018**, instituted for the offence under Section(s) 414 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that name of petitioner has been disclosed by the villagers.

In the written report it is alleged that villagers told the Police that petitioner along with two unknown persons after getting down from car run away towards maize field making firing. The Police found one empty cartridge and one abandoned car bearing registration No. WB-02-J-3101. The car belongs to brother of the petitioner.

Petitioner is in custody since 27.4.2019.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned **Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-XIV, Gopalganj**, in connection with **Barauli P.S. Case No. 211 of 2018**, subject to the condition that both the bailors will be the close relatives of the petitioner.
