APP for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest for the offences alleged under Sections 304/34 of the Indian Penal Copde, registered in connection with Karpi P.S. Case No. 115 of 2014.

4. At the very outset, learned APP submits that the FIR has been instituted as far back as in the year 2014, but the petitioner has approached this Court in the year 2019 and there does not appear to be any immediate apprehension of arrest of the petitioner.

5. Considering that the petitioner has not shown any immediate apprehension of arrest and the anticipatory bail petition has been filed five years after institution of the FIR, this



Court is not inclined to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Petition stands dismissed.
