2 11-07-2019 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in Masourhi P.S. Case No.
130/2018, instituted for offence under Section(s) 30(a) of the
Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

20 litres of Mahua liquor is alleged to have been
recovered from the place of occurrence kept in two plastic
containers. The villagers disclosed name of this petitioner and
other accused persons, who managed to escape.

It is mentioned in para 3 of bail petition that petitioner
has been made accused in one other case of Excise Act.

Petitioner is in custody since 03.05.2019.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances,
prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the



petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge (Excise), Patna, in connection with Masourhi P.S. Case No. 130/2018, subject to the conditions that both the bailors shall be the close relative of the petitioner.

The petitioner will file affidavit at the time of filing bail bond that he would not indulge in such type of activity in future. In the event, he is found indulged in such type of activity, his bail bond in the instant case will liable to be cancelled.
