Petitioners seek bail in **Digha P.S. Case No.17 of 2019** instituted for the offence under Section(s) 498-A, 307/34 Indian Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that Petitioners are father-in-law and mother-in-law of the deceased. It is submitted that compromise has taken place between the parties.

There is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners.
