2 12-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

In this case, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory
bail in connection with P.R. (Alamganj P.S. Case No. 189 of
2019 (Special Case No. 2286 of 2019) registered for offence
punishable under section 30 (a) of the Bihar Prohibition and
Excise (Amendment) Act, 2018.

An abandoned car was seized along with 26 litres of
illegal liquor.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
neither the petitioner is owner of the said car nor any person
identified the petitioner around that car and only on the basis of
information it has been alleged by the police that the petitioner
was involved in delivering the liquor on demand. The petitioner
has no criminal history.



Looking to the entire facts and circumstances of the case, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed and he, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks from today, is directed to be enlarged on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Special Judge, Excise, Patna in connection with P.R. (Alamganj P.S. Case No. 189 of 2019 (Special Case No. 2286 of 2019), subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438 Cr. PC and also subject to the condition that one of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court. The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence. The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court. If the petitioner is found involved in similar type of allegation in future, the prosecution will have liberty to file an application for cancellation of his bail bond.
