APP for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest for the offences
alleged under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code
registered in connection with Mehasi P.S. Case No. 40 of 2017.

3. At the very outset, learned APP submits that the
F.I.R. has been filed as far back as in the year 2017, but the
petitioner has approached this Court in the year 2019 and there
does not appear to be any immediate apprehension of arrest of
the petitioner.

4. Considering that the petitioner has not shown any
immediate apprehension of arrest and the anticipatory bail
petition has been filed two years after filing of the F.I.R., this



Court is not inclined to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. The anticipatory bail petition stands dismissed.
