2 15-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest for the offences alleged under Sections 147, 148, 149, 186, 341, 342, 323, 325, 307, 353, 379, 511 and 504 of the Indian Penal Code registered in connection with Salimpur P.S. Case No. 69 of 2019.

3. It is submitted that the petitioners have been falsely implicated and the FIR has been instituted as many as 11 named accused persons and 10-15 unknown. The accusations of assault are general and omnibus in nature without any specific assault attributed to the petitioners individually. The injuries sustained by Md. Saheb (Police Sub-Inspector) are simple in nature. The petitioners claim clean antecedents.

4. Be that as it may, in the event of the petitioners' arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks from the date of communication of this order, let the above named petitioners be



released on provisional bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-III, Barh, District Patna in connection with Salimpur P.S. Case No. 69 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C. and with further conditions --

(i) That one of the bailors of each of the petitioners shall be their close relatives.

(ii) That the petitioners shall not indulge in any similar offence till conclusion of the trial.

(iii) That the petitioners shall remain physically present in court on each and every date during trial and in the event of failure on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, their bail bonds shall be liable to be cancelled by the learned Court concerned.

(iv) That the petitioners shall cooperate with the investigation, if not already concluded, and make themselves available as and when so required and in case of failure, the State shall be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail.

5. The provisional bail granted to the petitioners shall be confirmed upon verification by the learned court below, preferably within a period of four weeks after furnishing bail bonds, that the injuries sustained by the injured persons are not grievous in nature, failing which their bail bonds shall stand automatically cancelled.
