2 15-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners seek bail in **Jainagar P.S. Case No. 197 of 2019**, instituted for the offence under Section(s) 272, 273, 414/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is alleged in the written report that 13.5 litres of Nepali liquor kept in bag with one Motorcycle has been recovered from possession of the petitioners. The Motorcycle belongs to petitioner No. 1.

Petitioners are in custody since 14.4.2019 having clean antecedent.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioners for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioners above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of **learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, 2nd, cum Special Judge, Excise Act, Madhubani**, in connection with **Jainagar P.S. Case No. 197 of 2019**, subject to the condition that both the bailors will be the close relatives of the petitioners.
