4 03-01-2019 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

In compliance of the direction of the writ court, the opposite parties have passed order on 31.7.2015 which has been placed on record by way of Annexure-A to the show cause.

Considering the aforesaid, the Court is not inclined to proceed any further, however, liberty shall be available to the petitioner to challenge the legality and validity of the order dated 31.7.2011 in appropriate proceeding.

It goes without saying that the opposite parties shall



ensure payment of the consequential benefit to the extent they have admitted in the order dated 31.7.2015 and ensure payment for the period 1.4.75 to 26.10.78 at the earliest preferably within a period of sixty days.
