2 16-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Section 394 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation is that four unknown miscreants snatched
the bag of the informant on gun point and took a purse
containing S.B.I. A.T.M. and Rs.1500/-.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 19.03.2019. Charge sheet has
been submitted in this case. There is no allegation of tampering
of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The name of the
petitioner has transpired in the present case on the self
confession before the police. No incriminating article has been
recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The petitioner



has not been put on T.I.P.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Gaya in connection with Moffasil P.S case No.89 of 2019.
