State.

The petitioner seeks bail in **Itarhi P.S. Case No. 78 of 2019**, instituted for the offence under Section(s) 25(1-b)a, 26 and 35 of Arms Act.

It is alleged in the written report that petitioner along with other accused was arrested by the Police. It is further alleged that on search of the petitioner, one Magazine loaded with three cartridges has been recovered from his possession.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that co-accused Ashok Kumar Singh @ Ashok Singh has already been granted bail by coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 4.7.2019 passed in Cr. Misc. 41000 of 2019.

Petitioner is in custody since 25.3.2019 having



clean antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned **Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-II, Buxar**, in connection with **Itarhi P.S. Case No. 78 of 2019**, subject to the condition that both the bailors will be close relatives of the petitioner.
