2 10-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with
Bihpur P.S. Case No.32 of 2019 for the offenses under Sections
341, 323, 324, 307, 354(A), 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal
Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Due to enmity between
the parties the present case was registered against this petitioner.
Referring to paragraph 9 learned counsel submits that earlier on
22.1.2019 a case was registered at the instance of the petitioner.
He further submits that injuries sustained by the informant side
is simple in nature. The petitioner is in custody since 24.3.2019.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has no



criminal antecedent, there is previous enmity as the case of the petitioner was registered against the informant side in earlier point of time, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-I, Naugachia, Bhagalpur in connection with Bihpur P.S. Case No.32 of 2019.
