Against the order dated 08.02.2019 passed by
the District Programme Officer, Gaya in Aanganbari Case No.
04 of 2019, the petitioner has already preferred an appeal
before the District Magistrate, Gaya *vide* Aanganbari Appeal

2. The first prayer of the petitioner in this writ petition is for issuance of a direction to the District Magistrate, Gaya to dispose off the aforesaid Aanganbari Appeal No. 37 of 2019, preferred by her, within a specified time.
