ORAL ORDER

2 19-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Bhargama P.S. Case No. 82 of 2019 for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 324, 325, 307, 354(B), 379, 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The informant is the own uncle of the petitioner. It is mentioned in the First Information Report also that there is land dispute between the informant and the petitioner. There is allegation of assault made by the persons named in the First Information Report, who belong to the same family.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that most of the injuries have been found to be simple in nature and no injury has so far been found to be grievous.



Considering the above submission, this application is allowed.

Let the petitioner above named, in the event of his arrest/surrender within six weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned J.M. 1st Class, Araria, in Bhargama P.S. Case No. 82 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

This is subject to the condition that the petitioner shall present himself before the Police/Court, as the case may be, as and when required and in the event of failure on his part to appear before the Court on two consecutive occasions, his bail bonds shall be liable to be cancelled.
