2 11-04-2019 This writ petition has been filed for quashing the order dated 15.9.2013 (Annexure-5) passed by the Conservator of Forest (Respondent No. 2) by which he has set aside the letter issued under Memo No. 679 dated 26.3.2012 issued by Divisional Forest Officer (Respondent No. 3) by which Respondent No. 3 has stayed the operation of Saw Mill and directed the Respondent No. 4 to produce the up-to-date agreement for lease of the premises.
