3 25-09-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as

learned counsel representing the informant-opposite party

no. 2.

The petitioner, in the present case, is husband of
informant-opposite party no. 2 and is seeking anticipatory
bail in connection with Mansahi P.S. Case No. 22/2019
registered under Sections 498(A)/448/323 of the Indian
Penal Code and $\frac{3}{4}$ of the dowry Prohibition Act.

At the outset, learned counsel for the parties
submit that they are ready and willing to live together and



the petitioner will take care of opposite party no.2 in the matrimonial home and shall keep her with full dignity and care.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner shall visit the Maiké/house of opposite party no. 2 within two weeks from today and shall bring her back to the matrimonial home where she will live with the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the opposite party no. 2 submits that if the petitioner visits her Maiké/house of opposite party no. 2, then the opposite party no. 2 shall accompany him and will go to live with the petitioner.

In the given facts and circumstances of the case, Let the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks, be enlarged on bail furnishing bail bond of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M. Katihar, in connection with Mansahi P.S. Case No. 22/2019, subject to condition prescribed under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, and further condition that the petitioner shall abide by his own



undertaking and shall bring back informant-opposite party no. 2 to the matrimonial home within two weeks from today where she will live with the petitioner with full dignity and care.

In case, the petitioner commits any breach of the undertaking and the conditions mentioned hereinabove, it will be open for the informant-opposite party no. 2 to file an appropriate application for cancellation of bail.

The application stands disposed off accordingly.
