2 11-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner has been transferred from Government
Polytechnic College, Bhagalpur to Government Polytechnic
College, Gopalganj.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has already filed representation before respondent
no.3, the Joint Secretary, Department of Science and
Technology, Government of Bihar. He further submits that the
representation of the petitioner is pending since 14.06.2019. He
submits that the writ application may be disposed of with a
direction to respondent no.3 to take appropriate decision on the



pending representation of the petitioner.
