2 12-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Section 366A of the Indian Penal
Code.

The statement of the victim-girl recorded under
Section 164 Cr.P.C., a copy at Annexure-2, reveals that she has
not alleged kidnapping or abduction by anyone, rather she is
specific that she had voluntarily gone to Jaipur.

Considering the statement of the victim-girl, let the
petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail
bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two
sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned
Court below where the case is pending in connection with
Budhuchak Police Station Case No. 24 of 2019, subject to the



condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
