2 16-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, O.P. No. 2
and learned APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Sections 302, 201/120(B) of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case in brief is that the petitioner along
with one another took the brother of the informant at night and
he did not return. The dead body and motorcycle of brother of
the informant was found thrown beside the road.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation
of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The
petitioner is in custody since 15-04-2019. Charge sheet has
already been submitted. It is a case of last seen. There is no eye



witness to the alleged occurrence nor there is any circumstantial evidence to suggest the participation of the petitioner in the alleged occurrence.

On behalf of the State and O.P. No. 2, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the petitioner named above is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sheohar in connection with Sheohar P.S. Case No. 47 of 2019.
