In the present case, the petitioners are claiming that their cases are squarely covered by the judgment and order dated 11.08.2015 passed in L.P.A. No. 1489 of 2011 (The State of Bihar and Anr. Vs. Sheo Bhajan Prasad Diwakar & Ors.).
