ORAL ORDER

- 3 13-09-2019 This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises
out of Bikramganj P.S. Case No. 403 of 2018, disclosing
offences under Sections 341, 323, 307, 498(A) and 34 of the
Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition
Act.

Petitioner happens to be husband of the informant and
allegation against him is of subjecting the informant to cruelty
in connection with demand of dowry.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is
that all the allegations are false and concocted and he is still
ready to keep the informant with full honour and dignity.

Heard learned A.P.P. as well as learned counsel for



the informant. Learned counsel for the informant has submitted that the informant is also ready to live with the petitioner, if she is kept with full honour and dignity as a wife.

Having heard both sides, considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this application is disposed of with direction to the petitioner to appear before the concerned court below on 26.09.2019 and if the petitioner files a petition that he is ready to keep the informant with himself with full honour and dignity and if he is willing to take the informant with himself from the court below itself, the court below shall extend the provisional bail of the petitioner for further period of six months and in the meantime, the court below will watch the conduct of the parties by calling the informant and petitioner in the third week of each month for a period of six months and after six months, if the court below is satisfied with the conduct of the parties, specially the conduct of the petitioner, he will confirm the provisional bail of the petitioner otherwise, he will pass any appropriate order as he deems fit and proper including cancellation of provisional bail of the petitioner.
