6 21-01-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and opposite
parties.

Learned counsel for the opposite parties submits that
the payments have been made to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner accepts the position
as to the payment, but refers to the order of the writ Court,
which indicates that if there is delay over one month, the arrears
would carry interest. He submits that the interest in terms of the
direction issued by the writ Court has not been paid.

Considering the fact that payments have been made,
the present proceeding is dropped. However, if the interest



payable in terms of the direction of the writ Court is not paid with calculation of the petitioner within a period of 60 days from today, liberty shall be available to the petitioner to file affidavit for revival of the present application.
