3 06-03-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Mahila Nawada P.S. Case No. 10 of 2018 registered under
Sections 363, 366A/376(D)/34, 504/506 of the Indian Penal
Code and Section 4 POCSO Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case
due to village politics. The present First Information Report has
been lodged after one week without any explanation. In the
medical report, the age of the victim has been stated to be
between 18-20 years and there is no external injury on her body.
Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the



case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of C.J.M., Nawada in connection with Mahila Nawada P.S. Case No. 10 of 2018, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
