APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under Section
379/511 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegedly, the petitioner was trying to starting the
motorcycle of the informant, parked in front of his house and in
consequence thereof, he was arrested.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that there
is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the
petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 05-03-2019. Charge
sheet has already been submitted. The petitioner has been made
accused in the present case due to mistake of fact. No attempt of
theft was made by the petitioner. The allegation, made in the
FIR is denied by the petitioner.



On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gaya in connection with Kotwali P.S. Case No. 115 of 2019.
