APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the offences under Sections 379, 411 and 414 of the Indian Penal Code.

Prosecution allegation, in short, is that two stolen motorcycles were recovered from the accused persons.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 11.4.2019. Charge-sheet/prosecution report has been submitted in this case. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. The petitioner had no knowledge that the motorcycles in question were stolen property. The petitioner had



been made accused due to mistake of fact.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is directed that the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. 1, Bhagalpur in connection with Akbar Nagar P.S. Case No. 21/19, G.R. No. 1495/19.
