2 02-08-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Kadam
Kuan P.S. Case No. 246 of 2019 for the offences under Sections
392 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since
25.04.2019. He further submits that the F.I.R. was registered
against unknown and petitioner was not named in the F.I.R. and
the name of the petitioner surfaced on the confessional
statement of co-accused namely Sanni Raj.

Considering the fact that petitioner has no criminal
antecedent and petitioner was not named in the F.I.R. and his
named was surfaced on the confessional statement of co-



accused, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, let the petitioner, named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court of learned Sub-Judge-VII-cum-Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patna in connection with Kadam Kuan P.S. Case No. 246 of 2019.
