2 29-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody for the
offences punishable under Sections 307/353/332/414/34 of the
Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Submission is that the FIR would reveal that firing
and counter-firing took place from both sides. However, no one
sustained fire-arm injury. The petitioner is in custody since
02.04.2019. Investigation of the case is complete.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner,
above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of
Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like
amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below



where the case is pending in connection with G.B. Nagar P.S.
Case No.22 of 2019, with following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below having immovable property in his name.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
